As verification, once your application is received, it will be either accepted or denied, an email will be sent for confirmation. **YOU DO NOT HAVE A BOOTH SPACE UNTIL YOU RECEIVE THIS VERIFICATION IN THE EMAIL.** We have very limited space for food vendors, as a result, only nonprofit food vendors are allowed at the Liberty Square Celebration. Those vendors who have been with us in the past will have first priority at the limited space, but are not guaranteed placement. Also, approximately 2 weeks before the event I will be sending you a brief letter informing you of your booth number, giving you a set-up time, and explaining in detail the rules and regulations for this event. If you need to request a specific set up time on Friday please include that information with the sheet you are returning to me. All booths will be required to be set up on Friday, October 8th. Please remember that you must be set up and ready no later than 9:00a.m. on Saturday. **No vehicles will be allowed in the square on Saturday all entrances will be blocked off.**

For those of you who have any type of food booth and need ice, we will have ice available for purchase during the event. There is a separate application for non-food vendors. If you would like that application please call the contact number.

Food court will be located in one area, all food vendors with the exception of baked items and "drink only" stands will be in this area. If your application is received after all available food vending spaces are filled, your application will be returned to you. We will return a copy of your approved/unapproved application to you by email. If you do not get a copy of your application returned to you within two weeks of mailing it to us, please contact us, this is your confirmation of booth space.

What electrical equipment will you be bringing to prepare food? Any items not listed on application will not be allowed. Please use back of sheet as needed.

All vendors must provide appropriate extension cords. Minimum 12 gauge cord is required for every three electrical items and use pigtail extensions, not to exceed 2 extension cords (see attachment). If more electricity is needed contact Coordinator by September 1. No power strips. No homemade cords.

We cannot guarantee specific space on the square due to electricity needs. Booths will have to be arranged at coordinators discretion. There will be no tables, chairs or tents provided.

I understand that the City of Sparta does not guarantee to me any amount of sales; I also understand that my booth fee is nonrefundable, unless event is cancelled by the City of Sparta (event will not be cancelled due to rain). I further understand that I cannot go over my allotted space (when measuring space needed please include necks of trailers).
