TO ALL SPARTA ELECTRIC AND PUBLIC WORKS CUSTOMERS WITH DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

As you know, we have not been executing disconnects for our customers who are having difficulties keeping their accounts paid due to the recent issues related to COVID-19 and their effect on the economy. When we made the announcement in March regarding these changes, we also made it very clear that we cannot forgive any amounts owed for the use of electric power or water. Our regulators, TVA and the Tennessee State Comptroller will not allow it.

Therefore, we are reaching out to help guide you through our options to bring your account current before June 8, 2020 to avoid disconnection of service.

- Pay your account in full by June 8th OR
- Transfer your past due amount to a six-month, no interest Pandemic Installment Payment Plan. The payments for this Plan will be made in addition to your regular power bill going forward; failure to keep the payments current on both accounts will result in penalties and disconnection.

Please read the enclosed flyer from UCHRA for information on their LIHEAP program to see if you qualify for additional assistance with your bill.

If you choose transferring the past due balance to the Installment Plan, you will be required to fill out new paperwork prior to the June 8th deadline.
