The City of Sparta is accepting bid proposals for the purchase of chemicals for the Sparta Waste-Water plant chemicals for the remainder of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022. Bid packages and information are available and can be obtained at Sparta City Hall, 6 Liberty Square, PO Box 30, Sparta, Tennessee 38583, telephone 931-836-3248. Sealed bids will be received until 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday April 19th, 2022 at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The City of Sparta reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities in a bid, to make awards to more than one bidder, to accept any part or all of a bid, or to accept that bid, (or bids) which in the judgment of the Board of Mayor and Alderman of the City of Sparta is in the best interest of the City. The City of Sparta, Tennessee will receive sealed bids for the purchase of the following chemicals until 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. All items are F.O.B. Sparta, Tennessee.

**Sewage Treatment Plant Chemical Specifications**

1. Chlorine – 150 lbs cylinders. Minimum delivery of 2 cylinders. Estimated use of 1-2 cylinders for this quarter. Must deliver within 72 hrs. to Sewage Treatment Plant.
2. Sulfur Dioxide – 150 lbs. cylinders. Minimum delivery of 2 cylinders. Estimated use of 2-4 cylinders for this quarter. Must deliver within 72 hrs. to Sewage Treatment Plant.

For our convenience, we do not wish to pay deposits on cylinders or drums. Empty drums may be picked up when deliveries are made.

All bid prices shall be firm for the entire period of May 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022. The award of bids may be split between two or more companies depending on prices of individual items, for example; one company may only be awarded bid for one item.

For each item bid, please include MSDS. Please list any other fees & their rates that may be charged such as fuel surcharges, freight, etc. in “Misc. Info” space provided. The City of Sparta shall pay no fees unless included in vendor’s bid.

Bids are to be addressed to the City Administrator and delivered to the Sparta City Hall, 6 Liberty Square, PO Box 30, Sparta, Tennessee 38583.

Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope and must be marked **“Partial Chemical Bid”** on the front of the envelope. All bids must be signed.

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In order to be certified as an acceptable bid, all chemicals included in the bid proposal must be approved by the operators in charge of the Sparta water and wastewater plants and also the applicable personnel at the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation Regional Field Office, Cookeville, TN. Bids may be accepted subject to approval by city staff and TDEC personnel, but purchase orders will not be issued prior to chemicals being approved by personnel of the appropriate agencies. Letters of certification must accompany all chemicals which differ from those that were previously approved for use in Sparta Wastewater systems.
