PURCHASING

4. Approve the purchase of two (2) Police Pursuit S.U.V.s from Lonnie Cobb Ford of Henderson, TN in the amount of \$73,758.00 (\$36,879.00 each) under the State Contract for the Police Department. These are budgeted items.
5. Approve the purchase of fifteen (15) Tasers model X26E and accessories from Accredited Security of Naples, FL in the amount of \$11,908.80 for the Police Department. These are sole source supplier and are budgeted items.
6. Approve the purchase of fourteen (14) handguns and accessories from Buds Police Supply of Lexington, KY in the amount of \$10,120.10 for the Police Department. Three quotes were received and the lowest chosen. These items will be acquired utilizing Drug Fund money.

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated 13-3-402 as amended, the Sparta Municipal Planning Commission recommends to the Sparta Board of Mayor & Aldermen that it approve, by a majority, the delegation of authority to the Planning Staff of the Sparta Municipal Planning Commission to preliminarily approve, and finalize the approval of, or certify a subdivision plat.
This is for split lots and two-lot subdivisions only, which is the current practice.
